Wenn langsam und deutlich gesprochen wird, kann ich kurze Texte und Gespräche aus bekannten Themengebieten verstehen, auch wenn ich nicht alle Wörter kenne.

Deskriptor:

Ich kann auch Einzelheiten verstehen, wenn ich die Texte mehrmals hören kann.

Beschreibung:

Die Schülerinnen und Schüler hören nach einer atmosphärischen Einstimmung einen Ausschnitt aus einer Radioshow und verbinden auf einem Arbeitsblatt Halbsätze mit Informationen aus dem Hörtext. Die Sendung wird dreimal vorgespielt.

ca. 10 Minuten

Die Aufgabe gilt als erfüllt, wenn 4 von 6 Sätzen richtig verbunden wurden.
