<b>Fertigkeit: Hörverstehen</b>	<b>Niveau A2</b> Wenn langsam und deutlich gesprochen wird, kann ich kurze Texte und Gespräche aus bekannten Themengebieten verstehen, auch wenn ich nicht alle Wörter kenne.
<b>Deskriptor:</b> Ich kann verstehen, worum es geht, wenn ich einfache Texte und Geschichten – auch von einer CD – höre.	
<b>Beschreibung:</b> Vorgespielt wird die CD mit der Geschichte "New girl on the block", Szene 1 und 2. Die Schülerinnen und Schüler erhalten ein Arbeitsblatt mit 8 Bildszenen der Geschichte, die sie ausschneiden und in die richtige Reihenfolge legen sollen.	
<b>Organisationsform:</b> Einzelarbeit in der Klasse oder zu Hause mit CD	
<b>Zeitaufwand:</b> ca. 15 Minuten	
<b>Erfüllungsgrad:</b> Die Aufgabe gilt als erfüllt, wenn die Bilder in der richtigen Reihenfolge sind.	
<b>Spiegelbild-Aufgabe:</b> <u>Schreiben:</u> Die Schülerinnen und Schüler schreiben zu jedem Bild mindestens einen Satz und kleben ihren Text zu dem passenden Bild.	
<b>Material / Medien:</b> Text Arbeitsblatt CD und Materialien von Ursula Asheuer: "Teddy Bear helps and other stories – Hörtexte für Englisch ab Klasse 4". Lisum Berlin, August 2003.	

## Transkript

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### **Scene one**

*Moving in.*

In England, there is a county called Essex.  
In Essex, there is a town called Seven Kings.  
In Seven Kings, there is a street called Mead's Lane.  
At number 37 lives a boy called Ralph.

*Ralph is standing at the window looking out.*

*Mum:* That's a removal van. I think we have new neighbours.

*Ralph:* Cool! Maybe there'll be a boy. We can play football together - brill!

A woman and a girl get off the motor-bike and walk up to Ralph and his mum:

*Sarah:* Hello!

*Mum:* Hello! Are you our new neighbours?

*Sarah:* Yes, my name is Sarah and this is my daughter Kate. She's nine years old.

*Ralph:* Yuk, a girl!

*Mum:* Ralph is nine years old, too. They can play together.

*Ralph:* I don't want to be friends with a girl. They can't play football and they're scared of spiders. I hate girls, they're stupid!

*Mum:* Ralph, don't be so rude! I'm sorry, Sarah. He's a naughty boy sometimes.

*Sarah:* Don't worry. Kate is also naughty sometimes.

*Kate:* Mum, I'm hungry!

*Sarah:* Oh, just a minute. I've brought something with us to eat.

*Kate:* But I'm hungry now!

*Mum:* Why don't you both come round for dinner?

*Sarah:* Oh, oh that would be very nice, thank you!

*Mum:* Okay, let's go into the kitchen. And you two, go and play.

*Ralph and Kate:*

Oh no!

*The two mums go into Ralph's kitchen.  
Ralph and Kate go into Ralph's garden.*

*Kate:* I don't want to play with you. Boys smell.  
*Ralph:* No, they don't. Girls smell.  
*Kate:* Shut up.  
*Ralph:* You shut up. I bet you can't play football. Girls can't play football.  
*Kate:* Yes, I can. I'm really good. My favourite football team is Manchester United.  
*Ralph:* Okay then, let's play. I'll win. Boys are better than girls.  
*Kate:* Come on, then. Let's play for five minutes.

*Kate and Ralph play football in the garden.*

*Kate:* I win, I win 3-2. Girls are better than boys!  
*Mum:* Come on, dinner's ready.  
*Ralph:* Mum, mum, Kate can play football! She's so cool! I think she's my friend now!  
*Mum:* Good. You can go to school together tomorrow.

## **Scene two**

*Kate's first day at school*

*Mum:* Time to get up, Kate! It's your first day at school!  
*Kate:* Mm, mmm... Ah, mum, where's my football shirt?  
*Mum:* Oh, Kate, not the old T-shirt for school.  
Put on your new school uniform.  
A grey skirt, white shirt, stripy tie and a black pullover. Very elegant!  
Now come on, hurry up!  
*Kate:* Okay, mum, but... I don't like it. It's too smart for me!  
*Mum:* Here's the skirt!  
*Kate:* Oh mum, it's too long. It's not cool!  
*Mum:* The skirt is fine. It looks lovely.  
But where's your tie?  
*Kate:* I don't like ties! Ties are for boys. Granddad wears a tie.  
*Mum:* Come on, sweetie  
Be a good girl. Put on your tie.  
Oh, don't you look smart!

*Kate and her mum eat breakfast in the kitchen. They eat a bowl of cornflakes. Then, the door bell rings.*

*Mum:* It's half past eight! Ralph's at the door. It's time to go.

*She puts her trainers on.*

*Mum:* No trainers at school! Put your new black school shoes on!  
*Kate:* Oh, mum!  
*Mum:* Have a nice day! And don't forget your schoolbag!  
*Ralph:* Hiya, Kate! Are you scared?  
*Kate:* No, of course not. I'm not scared of anything. Let's go, we don't want to be late. Bye, mum!  
*Mum:* Don't forget your schoolbag, Kate!  
*Kate:* Yes, mum. Bye!

Ralph and Kate arrive at school. There are lot of children in the playground.

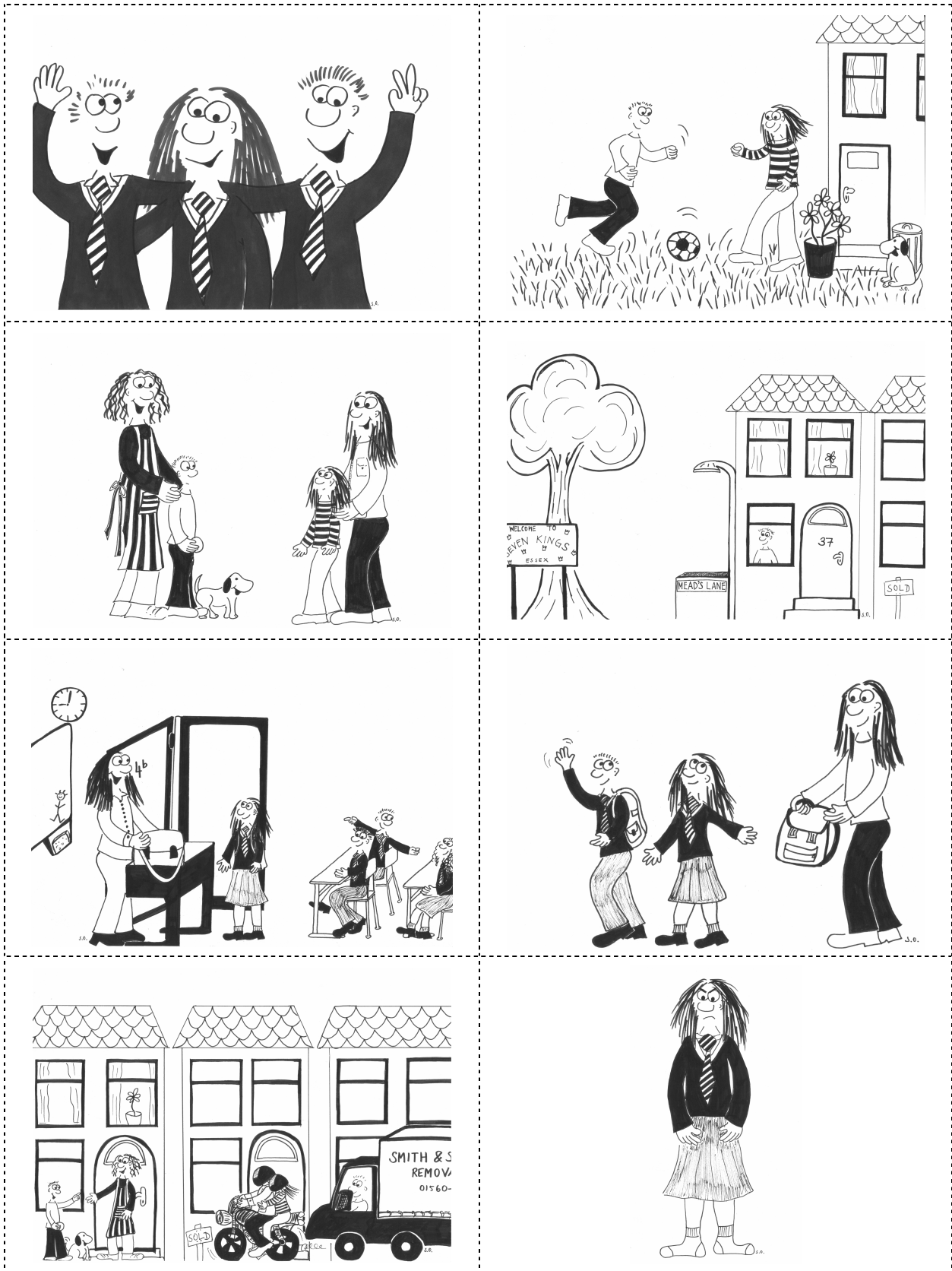
*Charlie:* Hi, Ralph! Who's this new girl?

*Ralph:* But Miss...  
*Mrs Philips:* Ralph! I said, be quiet!  
*Ralph:* But Miss, this is the new girl Kate.  
*Mrs Philips:* Oh, oh, I'm sorry, Kate. I didn't see you there. Welcome to class 4B.  
*Kate:* Thanks, Miss. Where can I sit?  
*Mrs Philips:* Hmm... Let's see. Oh, by the window next to Ralph. Right, get your books out, children and turn to page... Oh, is it break time already?  
*Kate:* Yeah, come on, let's play football!  
*Charlie:* What, you can't play football. You're a girl. Girls can't play football.  
*Kate:* Yes, I can! Ralph, tell them I can play football.  
*Charlie:* Well, well.. Let's just go and play.  
*Ralph:* She really is good at football.  
*Kate:* One goal to me, one goal to me!  
*Ralph:* She's so cool!  
*Charlie:* Cool girl Kate!  
*Ralph and Charlie:* Yeah, yeah, hooray for cool girl Kate!
