<b>Fertigkeit:</b> Hörverstehen	<b>Niveau B1</b> Ich kann längere Texte und Gespräche aus bekannten Themengebieten verstehen, wenn klar und deutlich gesprochen wird.
<b>Deskriptor:</b> Ich kann Anweisungen, Aufforderungen, Auskünfte ohne größere Mühe verstehen und darauf reagieren.	
<b>Beschreibung:</b> Die Schülerinnen und Schüler hören Nachrichten auf einem Anrufbeantworter, in denen es um die Organisation einer Party geht. Die Texte enthalten Anweisungen, Aufforderungen bzw. Auskünfte bezüglich der Organisation. Auf dem Arbeitsbogen befinden sich Notizzettel mit <i>multiple choice</i> Aufgaben zu den einzelnen Anrufern. Die Schülerinnen und Schüler müssen die richtige Antwort auswählen. Die Nachrichten werden zweimal vorgespielt.	
<b>Organisationsform:</b> Einzelarbeit zu Hause mit CD oder in der Klasse	
<b>Zeitaufwand:</b> ca. 20 Minuten	
<b>Erfüllungsgrad:</b> Die Aufgabe gilt als erfüllt, wenn 9 von 15 Aufgaben richtig angekreuzt worden sind (3 x 3 von 5).	
<b>Spiegelbildaufgabe:</b> <u>Schreiben:</u> Die Schülerinnen und Schüler schreiben <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- die Einladung, die in Text III gefordert wird,</li><li>- eine E-Mail an Mrs Richardson, in der sie erklären, warum sie sie nicht anrufen können, und in der sie dem anderen Raum zustimmen.</li></ul>

*Hello, it's me, Anna. I'm calling you because I don't have Fiona's number. Could you please ask her whether she's already sent the invitations for the party? I met some of my classmates in the shopping centre today and they asked me on what day the party was going to be and at what time. Could you please tell Fiona to send the invitations to everyone by email if possible. It's a lot faster than letters and there is not much time left until Saturday.*

*I also wanted to know if you still need help with the decorations. If so you can call me tomorrow morning at my grandmother's house and I'll be at the youth centre earlier on Saturday. Her number is 67510912. See you!*
