Fertigkeit: Leseverstehen	Niveau A2 Ich kann einfache Texte zu verschiedenen Themen im Wesentlichen verstehen, auch wenn ich nicht alle Wörter kenne.
Deskriptor: Ich kann geschriebenen Anweisungen (z.B. Hilfstexten in Computerprogrammen, Gebrauchsanweisungen, Rezepten) die wichtigsten Informationen entnehmen.	
Beschreibung: Die Schülerinnen und Schüler bekommen eine Anleitung zum Ticketkauf für öffentliche Verkehrsmittel. In einem ersten Arbeitsschritt ordnen sie die einzelnen Anweisungen den passenden Bildern zu. Danach müssen sie die einzelnen Anweisungen in die richtige Reihenfolge bringen.	
Organisationsform: Einzelarbeit	
Zeitaufwand: ca. 15 Minuten	
Erfüllungsgrad: Die Aufgabe gilt als erfüllt, wenn 4 von 8 Angaben richtig sind.	
Spiegelbild-Aufgabe: <u>Sprechen/Schreiben:</u> Die Schülerinnen und Schüler erklären den Ablauf (mit Hilfe der Bilder) und benutzen dabei <i>sequence words</i> (<i>First of all, then, next, finally, ...</i>).
